Instruction Recieved

Once we have received your Authority to Act form, your dedicated Consents Administrator will process this on our system.

Validation

We complete all the necessary technical processes such as: equipment validation using GIS and ownership verification using Land Registry digital services.

Submission

We submit your case with all the supporting evidence and documentation gathered and produced on your behalf.

Agreement

We receive copies of the wayleave agreement with the offer amount. We check the agreement before forwarding the it to you, with our advice about it's terms, for your approval and signature.





Completion

Once we have your signed agreement, we'll double check it and return it to the electricity network for their signature. It will be processed by their records team and signed by an authorised representative.

Payment

Once the agreement has been completed, we'll return it to you and we'll forward your payment from our client account either by cheque or BACS. The electricity network will pay our fees on your behalf.
